been named a semifinalist eligible to compete in the Texas National Geography Bee. The 2012 Texas National Geography Bee, which is sponsored by the National Geographic Society, will be held March 30 in Bedford. The winner of this state competition will receive \$100, the “Complete National Geographic on DVD” and a trip to Washington, D.C., where he or she will represent Texas in the National Finals in May.

Matthew said he is excited about the opportunity.
