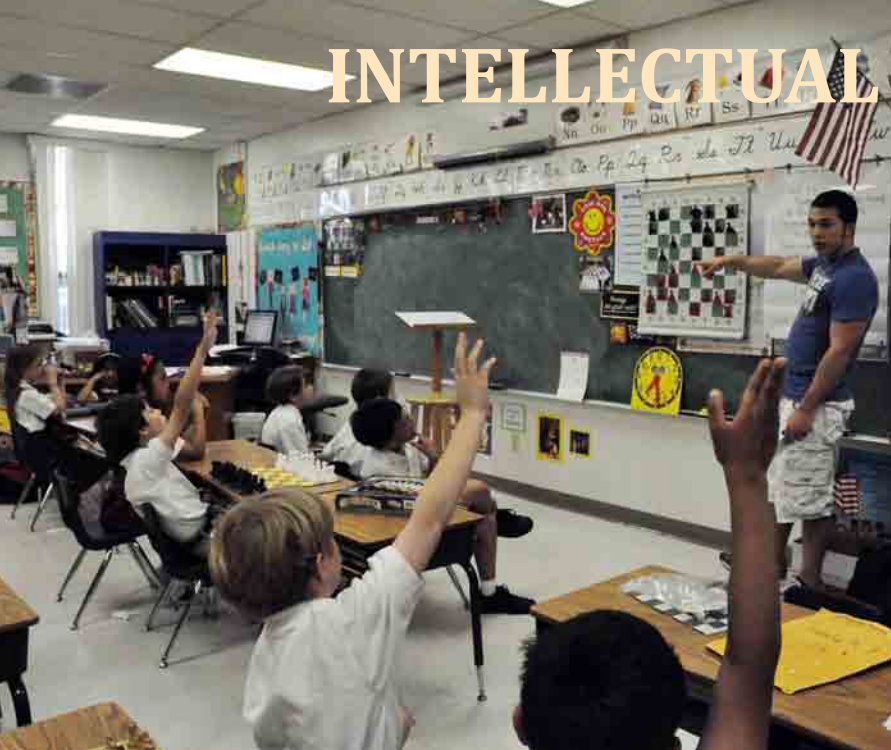

MIS received 90 ribbons in the St. Patrick Academic Fair, including eight 1st Place ribbons.

The MIS Speech Team earned 11 awards in the Bishop Dunn Speech Meet, including 2 Superior Perfect scores, 3 Superior scores, and 6 Excellent scores.

In the Jesuit Speech Meet, ten of our eighteen Speech Team entries received finalist ribbons, in addition to one 2nd Place trophy and one 3rd Place trophy.

Our Cross Country team held the top combined team points in the DPL.

5th grade Volleyball went undefeated and the 6th grade D2 Volleyball won the DPL Championship.

8th Grade D1 Girls Basketball won the DPL Championship.

Varsity Boys Tennis claimed the Doubles Championship. JV Boys Tennis received the Recreational win.

The JV Swim Team was the DPL Champion.

At the Bishop Lynch's 1st Annual Stars and Stunts Dance and Cheer Competition, the Highsteppers swept the competition with first, second, and third place in Dance Division 1 category. Highstepper officers received the Dance Division 2 trophy along with the "Superior Technique" award. The Spirits received the "Outstanding Precision" award.

OUR 2010 GRADUATES

53% of our 2010 graduating class is now attending local private high schools.

From this graduating class, two students were accepted into Cistercian Preparatory School, known for its high academic standards.

One graduate was accepted into the renowned Booker T. Washington School for the Performing and Visual Arts .

100% of the students from this class who applied to the Carrollton-Farmers Branch Academies were accepted.

90% of the students from this class who applied to local private high schools were accepted.

Four students from this class received scholarships that were based in full or in part on academics.

OUR FACULTY & STAFF

Three faculty/staff members received Work of Heart Awards from the Catholic Foundation.

Two new teachers joined our faculty: Kimberly Murawski and Kim Pfaffenberger.

Two new staff members were brought on to form our Office of Advancement: Holly Kerr (Director of Development) and Rosemary Martinez (Director of Communications.)

MARKETING/ COMMUNICATIONS

A deep market analysis revealed both external and internal factors contributing to low enrollment.

Public awareness of MIS through press releases was begun, resulting in 8 print-published articles from January through June. Several of these were printed in multiple news editions.

Increased relations with feeder preschools also helped increase awareness of MIS; however, enrollment efforts were severely affected by economic factors.

Improved communications within our community included the new format of the *Mustang Express*, a new Communications Policy, a customizable Google calendar system, and an on-line suggestion box.

An official fan site on Facebook was created, drawing 430 fans between September and June.

The MIS Alumni Association was re-formed with the onset of the Office of Advancement.

Alumni groups were invited to hold their reunions on campus; Class of 1965 and Class of 1999 took advantage of the offer.

As the school year came to a close at Mary Immaculate Catholic School in Farmers Branch, four graduating students had cause for extra celebration.

Jessica Marie Wiklund, Alex McIntyre, Thomas Gaubert and Francesca Gomez, all of Carrollton, received scholarships in tribute to their work during junior high. Mary Immaculate Catholic School serves students from kindergarten through eighth grade.

Wiklund was awarded a \$2,000 tuition scholarship by Academic Outfitters of Dallas.

Her poem submission, "A Broken Heart Stitched Together by God," was selected as a first-place winner in the company's

national Faith, Hope and Love scholarship contest from more than 900 submissions from across the country. Wiklund plans to attend John Paul II High School in Plano this fall.

\$20,000 grant received from Catholic Foundation towards Parish Hall revitalization.

\$42,695 was received through Scrip.
125 of 329 families opted for the buyout.

\$36,895 was received through the Magazine Drive.
245 of 329 families participated.
