Dear MIS Parents,

It's time to register for the 2008-2009 school year. Below you will find the tuition and fee breakdown for next year.

2008—2009 Tuition and Fees Information

Scrip Purchase Requirement		
Each family must purchase \$2500 of scrip certificates or pay the cash buy-out. The cash buy-out is either:		
1) \$225 if paid by September 1 st , 2008		
2) 10% of the remaining scrip obligation to a maximum of \$250 (due by April 30th, 2009)		
NOTE: First month's tuition due July 1, 2008. Tuition will be considered late after July 15, 2008 and subject to late fees. Remaining tuition is paid in 9 monthly installments due at the first of the month beginning in August. The last tuition payment is due April 1, 2009. Tuition, registration and new student application fees are <u>non-refundable</u>.		

* Mary Immaculate School is a ministry of Mary Immaculate Parish. Reduced tuition is offered to Catholic families who support Mary Immaculate Parish at a minimum of \$800 during a calendar year. To receive supportive family rates for the 2008-2009 school year, a family must have contributed a minimum of \$800 to Mary Immaculate Parish by 4/1/08. Families that do not complete the donation of \$800 by April 1, 2008 will be assessed the non-supportive rate for tuition. If a family decides to donate the required amount after July 1st their tuition will be based on a non-supportive rate and will not be made retroactive. Supportive status will be granted the month following the completion of the required donation. Families new to Mary Immaculate School will be required to make the \$800 donation to the church to be eligible for supportive tuition status.
