



## DRESS CODE & PERSONAL APPEARANCE

The school uniform must be worn at all times except on non-uniform days designated by the principal. If for any reason a part of the uniform cannot be worn, the student must bring a note from the parent or guardian.

All parts of the uniform must be clean and tidy. Uniforms are not to be soiled, ripped, torn or in disrepair. They must be labeled with the student's name. Writing on uniform or shoes is not permitted. Students who repeatedly violate the uniform policy will be denied participation in the next Buck-a-Jean Day.

The Mary Immaculate School Uniform Policy allows for students in grades 7 and 8 only to change from dress shoes to athletic shoes (tennis shoes) for P.E. All students in grades K-6 must wear the uniform shoes for the entire school day.

Uniforms and shoes must be purchased from Parker Uniform Company. Navy sweatshirts with the MIS logo are available through the school.

<b>Boys' Uniform</b>	<b>Girls' Uniforms</b>
Grades K-8: Khaki slacks or khaki shorts. Boys' pants and shorts must be worn at the waist level and with a black or brown belt.	Grades K-3: Plaid jumper or plaid walking shorts. Grades 4-8: Plaid skirt or plaid culottes. Minimum length of jumpers, skirts, shorts and culottes must be knee length (touch the top of the knee when knee is bent).
Grades K-6: White, short-sleeve knit shirt.	Grades K-3: White short-sleeve, round-collar blouse must be worn with jumper. White, short-sleeve knit shirt may be worn with walking shorts. Grades 4-6: White, short-sleeve, button-down collar or white, short-sleeve, knit shirt may be worn with skirt or culottes.
Grades 7&8: Navy blue polo shirt	Grades 7&8: Navy blue blouse
Only navy MIS sweatshirt may be worn over the uniform while in school.	Only navy MIS sweatshirt may be worn over the uniform while in school.
Grades K-8: New Balance 623 or K-Swiss Grades 7-8: May also wear Raider dress shoe.	Grades K-6: School Days Grades 7-8: Navy/White Classic
Solid white crew socks at least 2" above the top of the shoe.	Solid white socks at least 2" above the top of the shoe or white knee socks. Solid white or navy tights may be worn during cold weather.

## Personal Appearance

Good grooming has a bearing on classroom behavior and attitude. Hair must be clean and well groomed. Hair should be neat and natural looking with no extremes in style or color. Girls should not use ribbons/clips, bands or barrettes that detract from the colors of the uniform. Adornments in girls' hair must be red, white or navy blue. The maximum length of a boy's hair is above collar length, above eyebrows and above the top of the ears.
