

Dress Code & Personal Appearance

The school uniform must be worn at all times except on non-uniform days designated by the principal. If for any reason a part of the uniform cannot be worn, the student must bring a note from the parent or guardian.

All parts of the uniform must be clean and tidy. Uniforms are not to be soiled, ripped, torn or in disrepair. They must be labeled with the student's name. Writing on uniform or shoes is not permitted. Uniform infraction slips will be issued to any student not complying with the uniform code. **In grades 6-8 five infraction slips will result in a student receiving one conduct slip.**

The Mary Immaculate School Uniform Policy allows for students in grades 7 - 8 only to change from dress shoes to athletic shoes (tennis shoes) for P.E. and recess. All students in grades K-6 must wear the uniform shoes for the entire school day.

Uniforms are available from Parker Uniform Company; shoes are available from School Shoes Unlimited. Navy sweatshirts with the MIS logo are available through the school. Socks with MIS insignia may be purchased from School Shoes Unlimited.
