New Pre-K4

MIS will have double the number of little feet walking through our doorways this August. Our new Pre-K4 welcomes 30 new Mustangs in addition to our 30 new kindergartners. Our new Pre-K4 students will have their own uniforms and have the option to participate in half or full day programs. These mini-Mustangs will participate in our faith-based, engaging curriculum which encompasses early literacy, math, science, social studies, art, music, social growth and fine / gross motor practice with low student-to-teacher ratios. 

New Tuition Endowment

Thanks to a \$50,000 gift from Alumni Family Lisa and Louis Guerra, MIS introduced a new fund in late 2021. Within two months, MIS families rallied to raise the \$100,000 required to establish the official MIS Tuition Assistance Endowment Fund at The Catholic Foundation. We will distribute between three to five percent annually to assist families who require assistance to provide Catholic education to their children. On behalf of all our families who will benefit, thank you for your generosity.

MIS is grateful to the 700+ donors who supported our school this past school year. Because of you, we were able to make many improvements throughout the year and we have even more scheduled over the summer.

We kicked off the school year with a new parking lot, exterior lot lights, renovated lobby and, thanks to The Catholic Foundation, a new "poured in place" playground surface. Over the next few months, we're remodeling our Pre-K and Kindergarten wing, Music Room and Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atrium. An anonymous friend also provided full funding to resurface the gym floor and redesign our athletic entrance.


